

**Dear candidate (Data Subject),**

We would like to inform you that the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (“GDPR”) provides the new regulations for the protection of persons and other entities with respect to the Processing of Personal Data.

In accordance with the aforementioned legislation, this Processing will be based on the principles of lawfulness, correctness and transparency and protection of your confidentiality and your rights, in accordance with the principles contained in Article 5 of the GDPR.

In order to allow us to work with your CV, please read the information below and give your consent to the processing of your personal data.

In accordance with Article 13 of the GDPR, we therefore provide you with the following information:

**a) Purpose of the Processing.**

The data you provide will be processed for the management of the selection procedure and for the eventual award of the contract. The processing may also include sensitive data (e.g., health status and disability).

Candidates' personal data are processed by the administrative departments responsible for selection procedures and those responsible for formalising appointments, etc.

Please note that the data are processed with or without the aid of electronic tools; in the latter case, the computer systems are equipped, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter IV of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, with security measures to prevent data loss, unlawful or incorrect use and unauthorised access.

**b) Mandatory disclosure of personal data.**

We inform you that the provision of the Data is necessary in relation to the performance of the activities referred to in the preceding point, and therefore any failure to provide them or any refusal to consent to their Processing would make it impossible for the Data Controller to assess your professional aptitudes. If the procedure in question has been activated at your request (e.g., spontaneous sending of the curriculum), your consent to the Processing of “common” Data is not required, but consent to the Processing of “sensitive” data pursuant to Article 9 of the GDPR remains necessary.

**c) Categories of persons to whom the data may be transmitted.**

The data are processed by staff authorised by the Data Controller and by members of the Staff Recruitment Boards. Without prejudice to communications made in fulfilment of legal and contractual obligations, all data collected and processed may be communicated in Italy and transferred abroad exclusively for the purposes specified above to:

- consultants of the Data Controller appointed to carry out staff selection activities;
- associated companies controlling and/or controlled by the Data Controller, as well as companies, consortia and/or other legal entities in which the Data Controller participates as a partner;
- members and associates

For the sole purpose of carrying out the purposes of the collection as set out in point a).

**d) Data retention periods and other information.**

The data will be kept for the period of time strictly necessary to pursue the purposes for which they were collected. More specifically, the data collected as a result of the interview will not be stored, including the data provided by you with the presentation of your C.V., if the same is not followed up by decision of either party.

**e) Data subject rights.**

The data subject may obtain from the Company confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him/her exist in the Company's databases; he/she may also request and obtain the rectification or erasure of such data or the restriction of the Processing thereof; the data subject may object to the Processing; the data subject is also entitled to data portability; to withdraw consent (except in cases where the Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the Data Controller is subject or for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Data Controller); for the exercise of such rights, please refer to the contact details below. Finally, the data subject has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (Garante Privacy).
